Up to six people on each spot.

Sites will be reserved in a block.

Sites have electric and water is available on the loop.

We will be next to each other.

Reservations for (check in Wednesday afternoon) Wednesday night (13th)-Sunday check out (17th).

Pack-up Sunday early afternoon after Worship Time (available **4 nights stay**).

Come as soon as you can; stay as long as you can.

**Food Supplies:**

Bring all of your own food.

We will have a "steak night" on Saturday night (bring your own).

There is potable water around campsites.

**Activities:**

Hiking, fishing, games, relaxing (perhaps these are synonyms).

Fishing requires valid VA fishing license.

North Bend Park is located on the John H. Kerr Reservoir, a 50,000-acre lake (Buggs Island Lake) that extends 39 miles up the wooded, cove-studded shoreline of the Roanoke River in Virginia and North Carolina.

Kerr Reservoir, also known as Buggs Island Lake, was created with the construction of the John H. Kerr Dam in 1953. Its 800 miles of wooded shoreline stretch across six counties and offer countless recreation opportunities for visitors.
